Theme of this Sunday: The Church waits for her spouse. The first Christians used to often say, "The Lord is coming!" and they were always ready to receive hi. The theme of vigilance links together the three readings today. The second reading describes expectation and vigilance in the community of Thessalonica. The gospel continues the theme in a parable about vigilance. The first reading can be taken as a commentary on the gospel. The gospel teaches us that "those (virgins) who prepare themselves for the coming of the Lord are wise," while the first reading says that our most precious gift is the wisdom that comes from God.
